

Fishing Rules

All fisheries have to have rules to protect the health of the fish and to protect the general ambience for other anglers. We have put a lot of work into developing the lake, and the growth of the fish, and we want to protect them.



If you are new to carp fishing or unsure how to approach the lake please ask Andy and he will be glad to advise.

1. Barbless hooks only.
2. Minimum hook size 10.
3. Minimum line strength 12lb.
4. All anglers must use Nets, Weigh Slings and Matts provided. These must be saturated with water before use.
5. Rods must be attended at all times.
6. 3 rods maximum.
7. Be considerate to other anglers. Treat others as you would wish to be treated.
8. No fires or BBQ's other than those provided to be used.
9. No loud music.
10. All anglers must have in their possession (and use) Clinic or other brand carp antiseptic on hook holds and any sores or wounds on the carp. If a fish is caught with an injury please contact the owner on 07977 222884 and retain the carp in the water until instructed otherwise.
11. No Sacking of fish, they may be retained in the weigh sling in the water for 10 minutes while preparing for photographs to be taken if necessary.
12. No bent hook rigs, including Long shank curve hooks.
13. No nuts or particles other than sweetcorn/maize.
14. No fixed 'death' rigs. Lead clips can be used but the rubber tail must be gently pushed on, if used at all.
15. When using Zig rigs they must be fished 12 inches below the surface.
16. No bait boats.
